D. Balance Sheet revenue was moderately below budget for the period.

E. Cash Flow /Reconciliation
Net Revenue was ahead of budget for the month and is ahead of budget for the YTD. Expenses were below budget for the month and below budget for the YTD. The Net Operating Income was positive and above budget for the month and YTD.

The 340B revenue continued to perform below budget in the period.

MRH volumes were solid in the period. Patient days, Swingbed days, and Births were each ahead of budget continuing a strong trend in volumes in these

categories over the past few months. ED visits were slightly below budget but still a very solid total for the period.

Mr. Frosch and the committee noted that this was a solid month for volumes and operations.
